CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 13

For the purposes of the proceedings before the Special Master, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Amendment of the Comprehensive Case Management Order. The Parties' Joint Motion to Amend the Comprehensive Case Management Plan (CCMP) is granted.
 - (a) The proposed schedule in CCMP Appendix C, as updated in Case Management Order No. 11, is hereby amended. The new summary judgment briefing schedule is as follows:
 (i) summary judgment briefs must be filed by June 28, 2002;
 (ii) opposition briefs must be filed by September 12, 2002;
 and (iii) reply briefs must be filed by October 18, 2002.
 - (b) The parties may move for further revision of the summary judgment briefing schedule if they are delayed by an important discovery dispute. Any motion requesting additional time should describe the dispute in detail, and should propose a briefing schedule for promptly resolving the discovery dispute.
 - (c) The requirement in CCMP Appendix D that all exhibits must be permanently attached to the pleadings is hereby eliminated. The parties may submit exhibits in three hole binders or side-bound volumes separate from the briefs. The parties may use double-sided copying of exhibits.

(2) <u>Site Visit</u>. The Special Master and his legal assistant, Mr. Paul Rosenzweig, will participate in the jointly proposed Alaska site visit. The parties should contact Mr. Rosenzweig informally to obtain flight information and to attend to any other details.
