# CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 3

For the purposes of the proceedings before the Special Master, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- (1) <u>Procedure for Applications for Approval of Fees and</u> <u>Expenses</u>. The Special Master will apply to the United States Supreme Court for approval of fees and expenses on or about April 16 and October 16 of each year. The Special Master will distribute his applications to the parties so that they may file any appropriate objections. The Special Master will entertain a request from any party to alter this schedule based upon necessity or convenience arising from a party's fiscal calendar.
- (2) <u>Hourly Rates and Expenses</u>. The Special Master will apply for compensation for his time at the rate of \$250 per hour, and for the time of legal assistant Paul Rosenzweig and consultant Jonathon Siegel at a rate of \$175 per hour. The Special Master will apply for expense reimubursement based upon actual expenses incurred by the Special Master, his legal assistant and his consultant.
- (3) Orders to Pay. After approval by the Supreme Court, the Special Master will order the parties to pay the Special Master the amount of the approved fees and expenses.
- (4) <u>Required Paperwork and Procedures</u>. The parties will inform the Special Master of the required paperwork and procedures for obtaining the ordered payment from their respective treasuries. The Special Master will comply with these requirements.

(5) <u>Payment to Legal Assistant and Consultant</u>. The Special Master will be responsibile for disbursing approved fees and expenses to his assistants and consultants.
